

Obtaining Microsoft Visio 2007 through the MSDNAA

Microsoft Visio 2007 is available for FAU students to download and use. The following link allows you to visit the MSDNAA site to login and download the software.

You will be prompted for a login and a password. It should be the same as your initial FAU email login and password (For example: cnorona1@fau.edu and 00mmyy) if this is your first time logging into the MSDNAA.

The next window that should show up will say “My Software List.” Locate and click on the link that says **“To order new software click here.”**

The next window showcases only some of the software made available by the MSDNAA. To view more, click on the drop-down box which will provide a complete list of software that can be downloaded. Find and select **“Visio Professional 2007”** and then press the **“Go”** button.

Once you agree to the terms of the EULA the software product will appear in the “Shopping Cart” page. Click “**check out.**”

In the form, ensure that all of the information is correct and then click “**Next.**”

The next page is an invoice of the software you ordered. Notice the link that says “**Download.**” Clicking on this link will lead you to, yet, another page that displays additional information about your product but more importantly, the serial number. **Please note this 25-digit number for you will most likely need it later.** When ready click on the “**Download**” button.

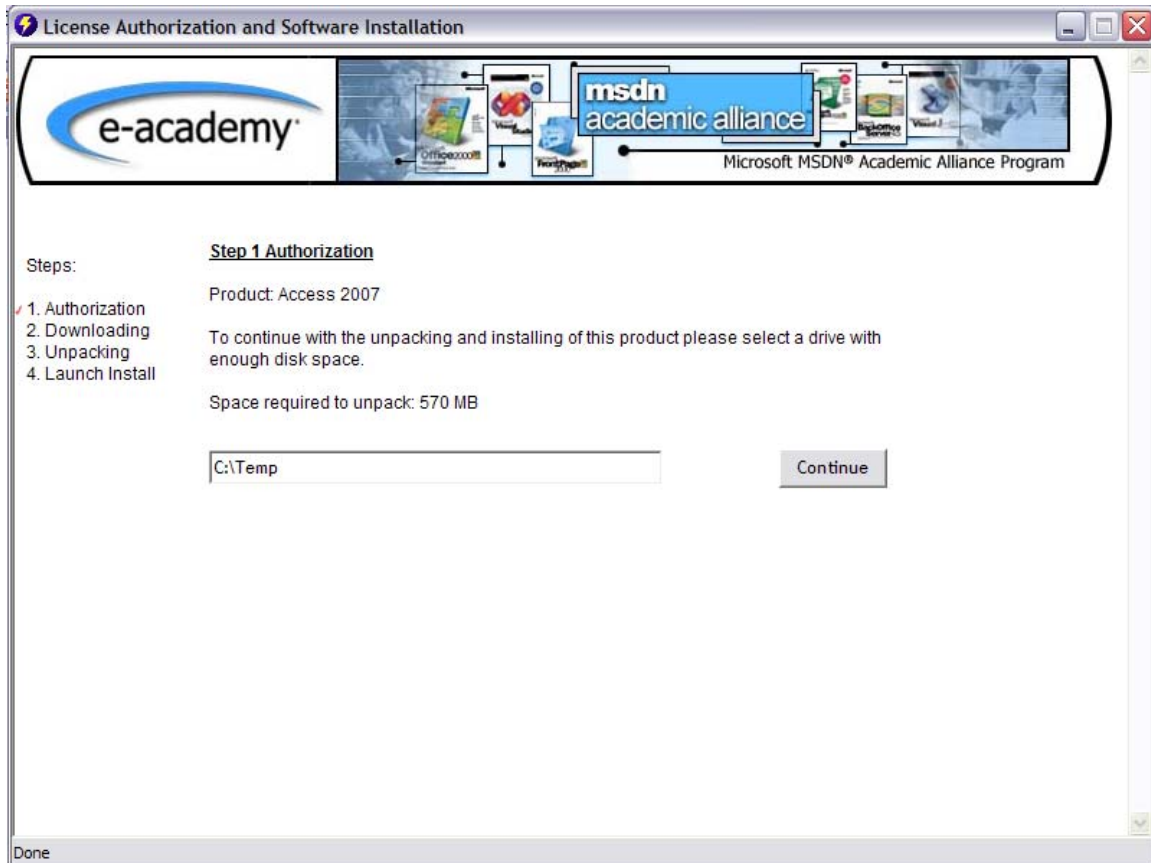

Notes:

If your download takes longer than 20 minutes, you may be prompted to log back in to continue using the website.

After you have completed the download, you may close your browser to complete your session.

You will be prompted to **run** or **save** the downloader. Once you execute this file a window will appear. Just enter the location where you wish to download the software and follow the downloader's instructions.



NOTE: Keep in mind the type of file you download. .ISO files are disk image files and will need to be burned onto a medium in order for you to be able to install the software.
